
## Regions of Georgia

Region Characteristics: Please know the following defining characteristics of each region.

<ul> <li>The Appalachian Plateau</li> <li>This is the smallest region of Georgia.</li> <li>A plateau is an area of high, flat land.</li> <li>The area also has mountains; two of these mountains are Sand Mountain and Lookout Mountain.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>The Ridge and Valley</li> <li>This region has long, narrow strips of land.</li> <li>The soil in the valley is good for farming.</li> <li>People grow fruits such as apples in this region.</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>The Blue Ridge Mountains</li> <li>This region has the state's tallest mountains.</li> <li>Some of the state's biggest rivers begin in the mountains of this region.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>The Piedmont Region</li> <li>This is the region where most of Georgia's people live.</li> <li>The land is hilly and has many forests.</li> <li>Many of the state's largest cities are in this region.</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>The Coastal Plain</li> <li>This is the state's largest region.</li> <li>It has flat or nearly flat land.</li> </ul>
